



The International Medical University is an educational innovative and research higher education instittion that has an international status and has passed independent accredittion for the accreditation of educational institutes and programs "SAPATTUU" BILIM". The International Medical University is included in the directory of the World Health Organization, as well as in the list of the educational commission for foreign graduates of medical universities in the United States. Diplomas of our university are recognized in the CIS countries, India, Pakistan, the USA and Canada. As of 01.07.2021, 1846 students study at MMU, of which 1520 are students from foreign countries and 326 students from the CIS and Kyrgyz countries.



About Bishkek

It is the capital and the largest city of Kyrgyzstan. It has a population of about 1 million and it covers approx. 169.9 km. It is located in the Chu river valley near the Kyrgyz mountains at an elevation of approx 3000 feet. The climate in Bishkek is of cold and temperate type. It mostly experiences rain in winter while comparatively lessrain in summer. The average annual temperature is 10.4 °C.



Eligibility Criteria:

The students will have to fulfill the below criteria to get into any of the Top Medical Universities in Kyrgyzstan:

- 01. The student should complete 17 years of age in the year of admission.
- 02. The student should qualify the 12th class (HSC) exam from Science and must secure A minimum of 60% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.

In general, there is appreciation of Indian culture. The Centre for Indian Studies set up in Osh State University in 1997 has been useful in providing an exposure to Indian culture and civilization to academicians and intelligentsia in this country. Our Mess (indian)

The kitchen facilities at IMU are available for students to prepare their own meals, fostering independence. However, during the first year, all international students are required to participate in the mess facility. The charges for meals may vary based on the selected options, but typically, a standard Indian meal plan consisting of lunch and dinner costs \$120 per month, while a plan including breakfast, lunch, and dinner amounts to \$200 per month. The hostel provides timely and nutritious meals, with breakfast, lunch, and dinner served at specified hours. The menu is regularly updated based on student feedback and the availability of seasonal vegetables. We firmly believe that a healthy body nurtures a healthy soul, emphasizing the importance of maintaining overall well-being.
